

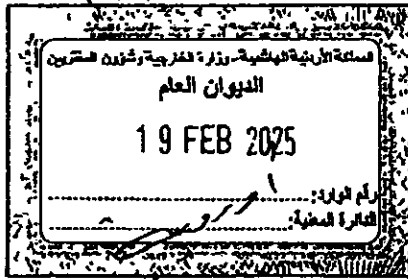

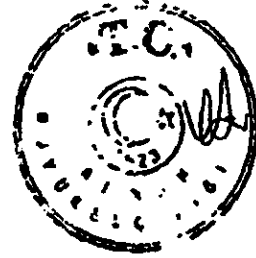

Those used one of the following procedures for the inactivation of PPRV are not covered by the prohibition;

(1): - Milk and cream for human consumption;

- a. Those applied a minimum temperature of 132°C for at least a second (ultra high temperature [UHT]) or
- b. Having a pH value of at least greater than 7.0, applied a minimum temperature of 72°C for at least 15 seconds (high temperature - short time pasteurization [HTST]), or
- c. Those with a pH value of 7.0 or more to which applied the HTST process twice.

**- Milk for animal consumption;**

- a. Those applied the HTST process twice; or
- b. HTST, with another physical process, e.g. maintaining pH 6 for at least an hour or additional heating to at least 72°C combined with drying; or
- c. UHT, combined with another physical process specified in (b).

**(<sup>2</sup>): Intestinal Sheath:**

Treated for at least 30 days with dry salt (NaCl) or saturated brine (aw < 0.80) or phosphate-buffered salt containing 86.5% NaCl, 10.7% Na<sub>2</sub>HPO<sub>4</sub> and 2.8% Na<sub>3</sub>PO<sub>4</sub> (wt/wt/wt); or as saturated brine (aw < 0.80) and those that have been kept at temperature of 20°C or higher for the entire period.

**(<sup>3</sup>): Blood, Meat, Bone, Horn and Hoof Flour:** Those have been subjected to heat treatment for a minimum of 30 minutes until the center temperature reaches at least 70 °C.

**(<sup>4</sup>): Leather and hides;**

- a. Those treated with salt (NaCl) including 2% sodium carbonate (Na<sub>2</sub>CO<sub>3</sub>) for at least 28 days or;
- b. Semi-processed hides and skins (calcined skins, pickled skins, wet blue and crust skins)

**(<sup>5</sup>): Wool and hair;**

- a. Industrial washing, comprising of immersing the wool in a series of baths of water, soap and sodium hydroxide (soda) or potassium hydroxide (potash); or;
- b. Chemical epilation by means of dead lime or sodium sulphide;
- c. Fumigation with formaldehyde in a hermetically sealed chamber for at least 24 hours;
- d. Industrial washing, comprising of immersing the wool in a water-soluble detergent maintained at 60-70°C;
- e. Wool that has been stored for four months at 4°C, four weeks at 18°C or eight days at 37°C.

**NOTE:** Animal products marked with (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) within the scope of the prohibition can only be imported by subjecting them to one or more of the processes or procedures specified in (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and provided that it is stated in the Health Certificates to be issued by the Veterinary Services of the exporting country that all necessary measures have been taken against the transmission of the sheep and goat plague disease virus to these products after the process with these processes or procedures (the process will be clearly stated).
